



How to Get Help with Health Insurance or Medical Care



On and Off the Marketplace

Safety Net Products & The Essential Plan: enroll at any time through the Marketplace

- Child Health Plus: for children up to age 19 who cannot get Medicaid.
- Medicaid Managed Care (MMC): for adults & children who can get Medicaid.
- The Essential Plan (EP): For those ineligible for Child Health Plus and Medicaid, but under 200% FPL

Individual Market Products: enroll during open enrollment or with a qualifying event

- On the Marketplace - Enrollment through the Marketplace
- Off the Marketplace - Enrollment directly through Health Insurance Plans

Have Questions? Need Help Filling Out Forms? Navigators, Certified Application Counselors (CACs), Marketplace Facilitated Enrollers (Marketplace FEs) and Certified Brokers

These are people who have special training to help you with the application process and understanding your options of health plans and products you can choose from.
